P128. Jeremiah Buckman was born February 05, 1671 in Boston, MA (Source: Town Records: MA: Boston.). He was the son of P256. John Buckman and Sarah. In March, 1684 Jeremiah Buckman, who had lived a long time at Ipswich with Joseph Lee, chose said Lee to be his guardian (Source: Probate Records: MA: Middlesex: Boston.). On March 09, 1714 Jacob Brown sold property to Jeremy Buckman of Ipswich, laborer (Source: Deed: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). From 1729 through 1731 Jeremiah was taxed in the Beverly district of Ipswich (Source: Town Records: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). In 1730 Jeremiah Buckman, yeoman, purchased land in Ipswich (Source: Deed: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). On March 27, 1731 an agreement was reached between Thomas Knowlton and Jeremiah Buckman Sr of Ipswich, housewright, to settle boundary lines [Jeremiah Buckman, Jr. of Beverly, cordwainer, signed under power of attorney dated March 17, 1730] (Source: Deed: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). On October 09, 1731 Nathaniel Jones sold to Jeremiah Buckman Sr. of Ipswich & Jeremiah Jr. 100 Acres in Sutton (Source: Deed: MA: Worcester: Sutton.). On June 06, 1732 Jeremiah Buckman of Lexington, carpenter, with his wife Sarah relinquishing her dower, sold to Ebenezer Knowlton land in Ipswich (Source: Deed: MA: Middlesex: Lexington.). On November 27, 1732 Jeremiah Bucknum of Sutton, cordwainer, quit claimed to Jeremiah Bucknum of Lexington, housewright, (my Honored Father) his half of their Sutton property (Source: Deed: MA: Middlesex: Boston.). In 1734 Jeremiah and his wife joined the Second Congregational Church of Sutton. On September 8, 1742 your petitioners, living, sum and most of us, very Remote from ye place of worship and having, sundry times, petitioned said Town for Releef, and hether to all our petitions have been abortive and unsuccessful yet, notwithstanding our Difficulties being so grate, we cant content our selves to give over seekin, hopinge we shall succeed at last – and, having thought upon a new skeem – which we think will pretty well accomodate us all, we pray that you would not Deny us this Request. To set us of three miles and an half wide by a parallel line iwht the northerly line of said Town. Beginning at oxford and Runing to grafton. In order to make a precinct, that so we may have the worship of God set up amongst us, which we think Cant but be a Reasonable Request and what we hope you will not Deny unto us, which as in Duty Bound we heartily pray for. ... Jeremiah Bukman ... Daniel Buckman ... Thomas Gould ... Jeremiah Buckman, Junr ... The town, however, refused to set off the precinct in answer to the petition, whereupon the petitioners applied to the General Court and asked that

they be set off as a precinct by special enactment. The town sent a committee to oppose the granting of this request. Nevertheless, the General Court reported favorably for the petitioners and in February, 1743, sent a committee to visit the town and hear the parties interested (Source: History of Sutton, MA.). On October 20, 1743 Jeremiah Buckman of Sutton, house-carpenter, sold to Joseph Bucknum of Sutton, weaver, housing and land where I now dwell and contains by estimation 60 Acres in consideration of the sum of £20 paid by my son and also in consideration of his mortgage of the premises to myself and present wife for performing certain considerations and paying certain sums to my daughters as therein expressed...That whereas said Jeremiah Bucknum doth account that the above said land and buildings were worth £100 lawful money, out of that (he) reserved to (himself) and present wife Hannah, £37 10s. for support during life and that the remainder being £62 10s. should be divided to and amongst the said Joseph and his four sisters or their lawful representatives, namely: Martha Rogers, Hannah Masters, Sarah Dike, and Deborah Hull, said division to be equal and said daughters part to be paid within 4 years after the decease of the said Jeremiah Bucknum and said wife (Source: Deed: MA: Worcester: Sutton.). On October 28, 1743, an order was passed establishing precinct No. 2, according to a line drawn three miles south of and parallel to the northerly line of the town. On November 11, 1743, an additional provision was made, by vote of the General Court, which compelled the inhabitants in this newly established precinct to pay their proportion of all ministerial charges in the town up to March, 1744. Worcester, ss.} To Richard Moore, Esq., one of his Majesties Justices & c. We the Subscribers, Inhabitants of ye Second Precinct in Sutton in said County hereby signify to you our Desire that a warrant may issue agreeable to law for calling a Meeting in said Precinct as soon as may be &c. Jeremiah Buckman, Daniel Buckman, Thomas Gould ... Worcester, ss.} To Jeremiah Buckman, Jr., of Sutton in ye county of Worcester, Greeting: - You are hereby required in his majesties name to warn and give notice to ye freeholders and others, inhabitants in ye second parish, in Sutton aforesaid, qualified to vot in Town affairs, that they must meet at the house of Mr. Richard Singletary, in said Sutton, in said precinct, on Monday, the twenty-sixth day of December, instant, at nine of ye clock in ye forenoon, then and there to act on each of ye particulars expressed in above request. By posting a copy of the request and this warrant at such public places in said precinct, hereof fail not and make return hereof and of your doings hearin at or before ye said twenty-six day of December instant at nine o'clock in the morning. Given under my hand and seal at Oxford, this Eight Day of December A. D., 1743, Richard Moore, Justice of the Peace. On December 26, 1743 by virtue of this Warrant, to me Directed, I have notified ye Freeholders and other Inhabitants of this ye same at Mr. John Singletary's Mill Doore. By Mr. Jeremiah Buckman, one of the Petitioners of S'd Warrant. On December 26, 1743 the first meeting of the parish was held at the house of Richard Singletary, which was situated at the outlet of Crooked Pond, now Singletary Lake. The moderator was Captain Timothy Carter, and Robert Goddard was the clerk. The parish continued to hold meetings at this house until May, 1745, and religious services also were held here for some time (Source: History of Sutton, MA.). On January 9, 1746 at a Chh Meeting Willis Davidsons Caller of reasons was read and deferred as also some other matters respecting Jeremiah Bucknam: reasons for absenting; there being a this Chh meeting attest David Hale Pastor (Source: Church Record: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 2nd Church.). On March 3, 1747 Joseph Bucknum of Oxford, weaver, sold to his brother Daniel Bucknum of Sutton, cordwainer, the Sutton land I hold by virtue of a deed from my honored Father, receiving £20...Daniel then had to furnish a bond that he would comply with the considerations of the first mortgage. Daniel then paid off his brothers and sisters to clear the title of the land. We: Jeremiah Bucknum, cordwainer of Sutton; Joseph Bucknum, weaver of Oxford; Thomas Gould, laborer of Sutton, and Hannah; Richard Rogers, schoolmaster of Oxford, and Martha; John Dike, laborer of Sutton, and Sarah; James Hull, laborer of Worcester, and Deborah; the said Hannah, Martha, Sarah, and Deborah being daughters of Jeremiah Bucknum of Sutton, carpenter, and also Mary Hooker of Marblehead, widow, yet another daughter of said Jeremiah, in consideration of ye full sum of £15 Old Tenor Bills of Credit paid respectively to them, the receipt of which they each acknowledge, therefore do freely and absolutely grant, bargain, sell and convey to Daniel Bucknum and to his heirs and assigns forever all rights which may come to them from the estate of their father Jeremiah Bucknum on his decease (Source: Deed: MA: Worcester: Sutton.). On March 12, 1746 a regular chh meeting the matter of Jer: Bucknam, was considered a paper of his read, and the Comtee report related, recording to us it was unsatisfactory to ye chh, for that it approved him J. as sole reason of his absenting from the sacrament was a pastor of chh dealing with some members showed it in fact appeared otherwise. J. bucknam declared that he was in veritee with ye pastor & all y Brethern, ye Question being put to him. But sundry of the brethren ... they were aggrement and unsatisfied with him in to he had conducted as he had done and appeared unhumblid so ye matter was deferred to the next chh meeting (Source: Church Record: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 2nd Church.). On May 25, 1747 Hannah, Daniel & Jeremiah Jr, petitioned that our said Husband and Father is incapable of taking care of his worldly affairs. Three neighbors also deposed to this and that it is needfull he should have a guardian (Source: Probate Records: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 8735.). On July 16, 1747 at a chh meeting Br. Jer: Bucknams case further deferred and an acknowledgment in writing required. On August 13, 1747 at a regular meeting a Br: jer: Bucknam brought an acknowledgment wc was read and not accepted being put to vote. Afterwards the chh voted a letter of admonition and inspection to be prepared against the next chh meeting

... the 2nd Thursday of Sep, to be given him provided he was not tender the chh a proper satisfaction (Source: Church Record: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 2nd Church.). On August 19, 1747 Jeremiah Buckman, Jr. presented an inventory for the estate of his father, Jeermiah Buckman, Sr. said Persona Non Compos (Source: Probate Records: MA: Worcester: Sutton.). On September 9, 1747 as a regular chh meeting Jer: Bucknam, case still deferred as not satisfied yet not thinking proper ... to proceed (Source: Church Record: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 2nd Church.). On November 12, 1747 Jeremiah Bucknams confession read & accepted (Source: Church Record: MA: Worcester: Sutton: 2nd Church.). On December 10, 1747 the Second Church was officially organized and adopted the Cambridge platform. Daniel and Phebe Buckman, Thomas and Martha Gould, were dismissed from the First Church in Sutton to form the Second Congregational Church of Sutton, now Millbury (Source: History of Sutton, MA.). Jeremiah and Sarah also had a son John.

In 1778 Mary Buckman, residing with her son Amos, was "warned out" as the town feared she would become a town charge and she had not gotten permission to move there Source: Town Record: NH: Chesshier: Fitzwilliam.). John, son of Joseph Buckman, was baptized November 14, 1725 (Source: Vital Records: Births: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). Joseph, son of Jos. and Mary Buckman, was baptized May 26, 1728 (Source: Vital Records: Births: MA: Essex: Ipswich.). June 18, 1776 pay abstract for travel allowance, etc. September 17, 1776 petition for increase and payment of wages dated Camp at Hull, MA. November 1, 1776 discharged after service at Camp Hull, MA. May 5, 1777 enlisted for term of 2 months in Captain William Henry's Company of Colonel Whitney's regiment. July 5, 1777 discharged as Private after service at Rhode Island June 5, 1780 raised to reinforce Continental Army for the term of 6 months and described as 20 years old resident of Athol, MA who stands 5'9" and has a light complexion.

July 6, 1780 arrived at Springfield, MA. July 7, 1780 marched to camp under command of Captain Dix. October 25, 1780 returned by Brigadier General Paterson as having passed muster (dated Camp Totoway). December 5, 1775 enlisted until January 15th, next in Captain Daniel Haws's Company of Colonel Samuel Holden Parsons's 10th regiment. December 6, 1775 forwarded to camp as Private by John Caldwell, one of enlistment committee for Worcester Co.

July 28, 1777 enlisted in Captain Peter Woodbury's Company of Colonel Job Cushing's regiment.

Aug. 29, 1777 discharged as Private after march to Bennington, VT to reinforce General Stark.

March 27 1778 enlisted in Captain William Marean's Company of Colonel Stearns's 1st regiment of guards. June 1, 1778 reported sick and absent on roll call. July 2, 1778 discharged as Private after guarding troops of convention at Cambridge, MA. October 24, 1779 enlisted in Captain Jotham Houghton's Company of Colonel Samuel Denny's 2nd regiment within General Fellows's brigade

Doctor Amasa Bucknum was baptized October 23, 1768 in Athol, MA (Source: Vital Records: Births: MA: Worcester: Athol.) and died June 15, 1856 in Stanford, NY [Age: 88y] (Source. Cemetery: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Bear Market Community Ground.). He married Anna Karner April 12, 1793 in Sheffield, MA (Source: Town Records: MA: Berkshire: Sheffield.). She died October 09, 1855 in Stanford, NY [Age: 82y] (Source. Cemetery: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Bear Market Community Ground.). The genealogy of the Bucknum family: Line of Dr. Amas Bucknum, First (my great-Grandfather), Dr. Amasa Bucknum graduated at Oxford, England. Three brothers came from England, all physicians; one of them, Dr. Amasa Bucknum, settled in Stanford, Dutchess Co., NY some time prior to the year 1790. He married Ann Karner, daughter of Jacob of Egremont, Berkshire Co., MA. They had 12 children; Calvin, Samuel, Joseph, Amasa, and Laura, the rest died young, except 2 daughters, who lived to marry, then died (1 m. a Seeley & the other a Caswell) (the daughter who married a Seeley had one child, a son, Karner) (Source: Letter: William Magnum Bucknum.). Mary Bucknum, daughter of Dr. Amasa, died May 20, 1826 in Stanford, NY [Age: 23y, 11m] (Source. Cemetery: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Bear Market Community Ground.). James S. Bucknum drowned September 03, 1836 in Stanford, NY [Age: 26y, 6m] (Source. Cemetery: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Bear Market Community Ground.). Hannah Bucknum, daughter of Dr. Amasa & Anna, died March 17, 1844 in Stanford, NY [Age: 31y, 9m, 22d] (Source. Cemetery: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Bear Market Community Ground.). On September 4, 1850 Amasa Buckman, 81 year old Farmer born in NY, with \$3500 worth of real property; Anna, 78 year old born in NY; Laura Bullock, 56 year old born in NY; Hannah W., 23 year old born in NY; Joseph Buckman, 42 year old Laborer born in NY; were living at household 316 (Source: Census: 1850: NY: Dutchess: Stanford: Page: 480: Line: 15.). Samuel Bucknum appears as a farmer in the 1850, 1860, and 1870 census of Spring Arbor Township, Jackson Co., Michigan. All 3 census years confirm that he was born in 1798 in New York, and all 3 show him to be a farmer. In 1870 an Ann Bucknum, age 66, was shown in the household along with another person named "Joann Pulverauhe", F, Age 11, Servant. Also appearing in the 1870 census index of Atchison Co., is a David Bucknum/Buckurum.

Samuel obtained United States Land Certificate No. 5313 for land for sale at Monroe, Michigan Territory. The date on the certificate was 18 March 1837. Samuel was listed as "Samuel Bucknum of Wayne County New York". The land was described as "The E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 20 in Township 3 South, of Range 3 West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Monroe Michigan Territory containing 80 acres. Also obtaining land was Clarissa Bucknam, 40 acres. According to online records of the Bureau of Land Management, Eastern Division, there were no other Bucknum's listed in the state of Michigan.

In later years, Samuel was said to be a Justice Of Peace.

On September 22, 1827 John Cronkhite filed for clear title to the farm of Anthony Cronkhite, deceased, in New York. Included in the petition were Clarissa and Samuel Bucknum of Rose, NY; Polly and Daniel Post of Barrington, NY; Sally and Andrew Case of Stanford, NY; and Elizabeth Cronkhite, widow. It is thought that Polly and Sally were sisters of Clarissa. The Daniel Post may have been the name source for Daniel Post Bucknum, son of Samuel and Clarissa.

Mrs Jack E. Bucknum of San Rafael CA, the widow of a grandson of J. R. Bucknum, said that Daniel's body was carried by horse drawn hearse from San Rafael to Oakland to be buried. This was reported to Jack by his uncle Herb Bucknum.

By phone call to the cemetery, Daniel Post Bucknum was confirmed to be buried at Mountain View Cemetery in Oakland CA. Date of death was recorded as 20 Feb 1910. He is buried in Plot 4, Lot 199, East Portion, Grave 2.
